

### What is Empathy?

**Empathy** involves understanding another's feelings, thoughts, and wishes, and then communicating this understanding back.

- -What do you think we mean by "understanding?"
- -Why do you think this is important?



# It's all about gaining another's perspective. We all see things differently.

### Three Steps to Empathy

- 1. Listen
- 2. Identify the person's feelings, thoughts, and needs
- 3. Communicate your understanding with the person

# Which response do you think would be an example of Empathy?

#### What do you say?

#### Remember your three steps:

- 1. Listen
- 2. Identify the person's feelings, thoughts, and needs
- 3. Communicate your understanding with the person

# What is the difference between Sympathy, Empathy, and Apathy?

Sympathy - Feelings of pity and sorrow for someone else's misfortune

Empathy - The ability to understand and share the feelings of another

Apathy - A lack of interest, enthusiasm, or concern


Discuss why these differences change interactions between people.
